



How to create glitter tattoos

Step #I

Clean the skin with alcohol and allow it to dry completely. Any moisture, sweat, or lotion will cause the glitter to stick everywhere, instead of just where you want it.

Step #2

Use a paint brush to apply a light coat of the adhesive to the skin. ***White Taklon bristled brushes work best.

Step # 3

Allow the adhesive to dry to a clear tack. Then use the glitter bottles to "poof" glitter onto the areas where you want it.

Step #4 Use a cosmetic brush to sweep away excess glitter

If you like, you can use alcohol based body paints, such as our Tribal Ink to outline your glitter tattoos.





Self-Adhesive Stencils

To use the self-adhesive stencils, peel away the white backing. Press the stencil onto the skin and peel away the clear protective sheet. Apply our acrylic adhesive to the open spaces (our lip-gloss-type applicator vials work great for this) and allow it to dry clear. Rub glitter onto the adhesive and peel off the stencil.



Use 99% rubbing alcohol (or 91%) to clean your brushes or to remove glitter tattoos

Use the bulb pipette to fill our lip-gloss-type applicator vials with adhesive for easy application over stencils - Also a great tool for writing names & other freehand doodles
